Courtesy Pay Coverage Summary and Options for Business Accounts

City CU may pay your overdrafts for checks and electronic debits (ACH), unless, you tell us you do not want courtesy pay coverage for these transactions. These items may result in an overdraft fee from City CU, however may prevent merchant fees and eliminate the embarrassment that would be caused by a returned item.

Even if you do not request Courtesy Pay coverage, City CU may pay your overdrafts for other types of transactions, including checks, ACH and other electronic transactions.

Courtesy Pay coverage does not guarantee that we will pay your overdrafts. If we decide not to pay an overdraft, you will be charged a non-sufficient fund fee as described in our fee schedule.

Other Ways We Can Cover Your Overdrafts

We offer other ways of covering your overdrafts that may be less expensive. Courtesy Pay coverage differs from other overdraft services we offer, such as linking your account to another account with us or an overdraft line of credit.
